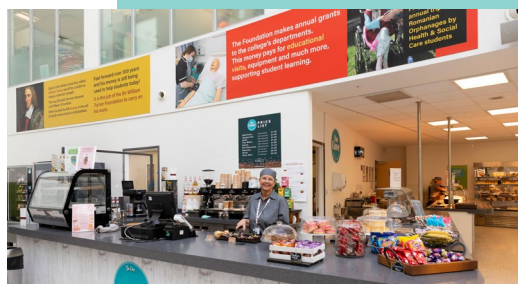
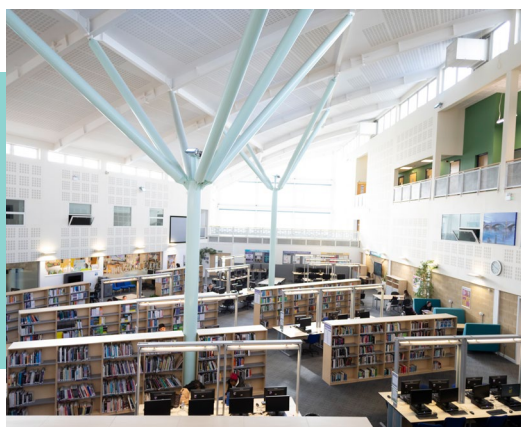
Campus Life

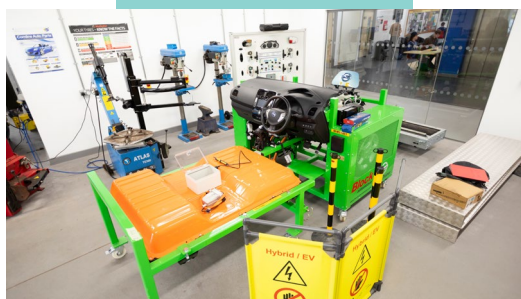


LEISURE FACILITIES

Fees and Finance

ENGLISH AND MATHS

All GCSE and Functional Skills maths and English courses are **free** to adults aged 19 and over who do not hold a grade C/4 or above in GCSE English or maths.

FREE LEVEL 2 DISTANCE LEARNING COURSES

Level 2 distance learning courses are fully funded if you are aged 19+ and have lived in England for a minimum of three years.



ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

If you are planning to study a level 3-6 further education course or access to higher education diploma and you are aged 19+ you may qualify for an Advanced Learner Loan. Students can apply for a loan to meet the upfront costs of their qualification, which will be paid directly to the college on their behalf.

An Advanced Learner Loan falls under Plan 5, in the below link, and repayments only start when earning an annual salary of **£25,000** or more a year. If the loan is for an Access to Higher Education Diploma and you subsequently go on to complete a higher education course, you won't have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.

KING'S TRUST TEAM PROGRAMME

The King's Trust Team programme is a 12-week personal development course aimed at young people aged 16-25 who are currently unemployed. The King's Trust Certificate in Employment, Teamwork and Community Skills is available at Levels E3, L1 and L2.

Team is offered at a variety of centres throughout the North East including Stockton, Middlesbrough, Redcar, Catterick, Bishop Auckland and Darlington, with start dates throughout the year.

KING'S TRUST ACHIEVE PROGRAMME

The King's Trust Achieve programme is a year-long course for young people aged 16-18 who are unsure of what vocational area to progress on to or may need to develop their confidence.

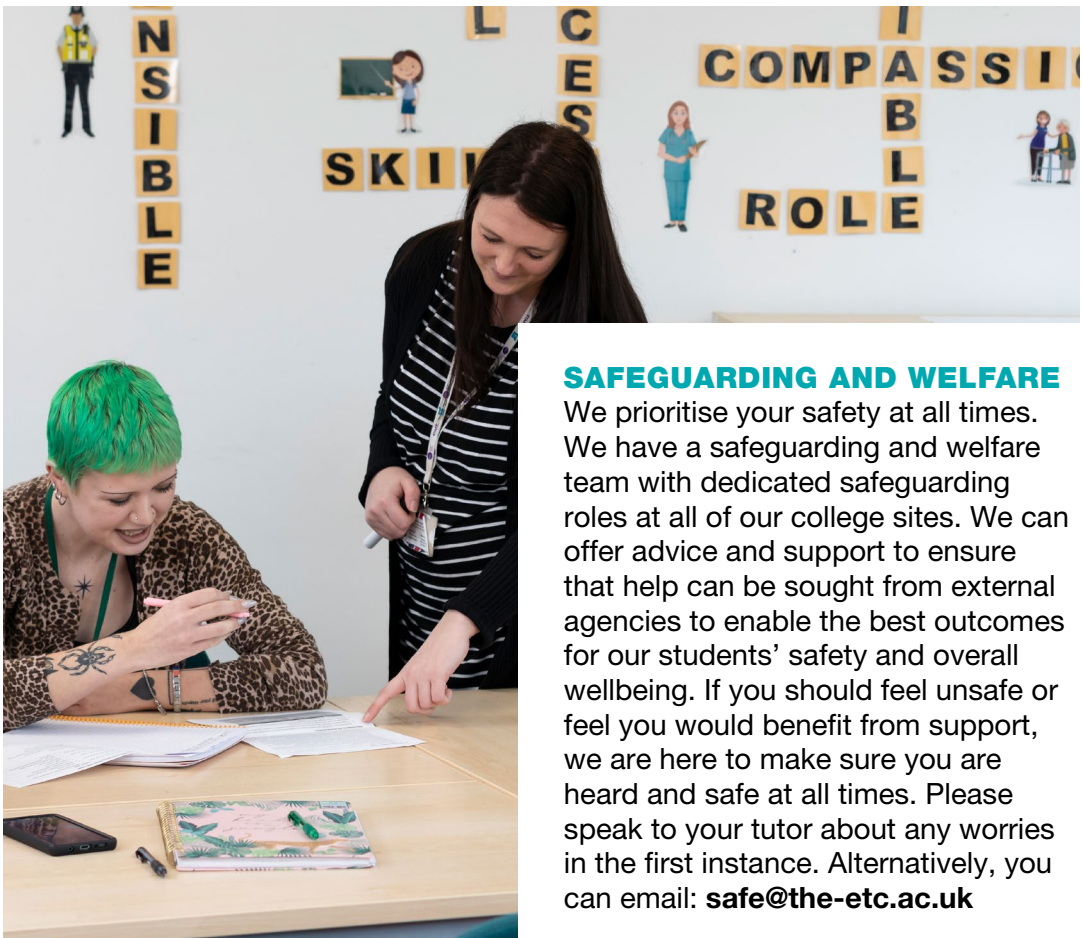

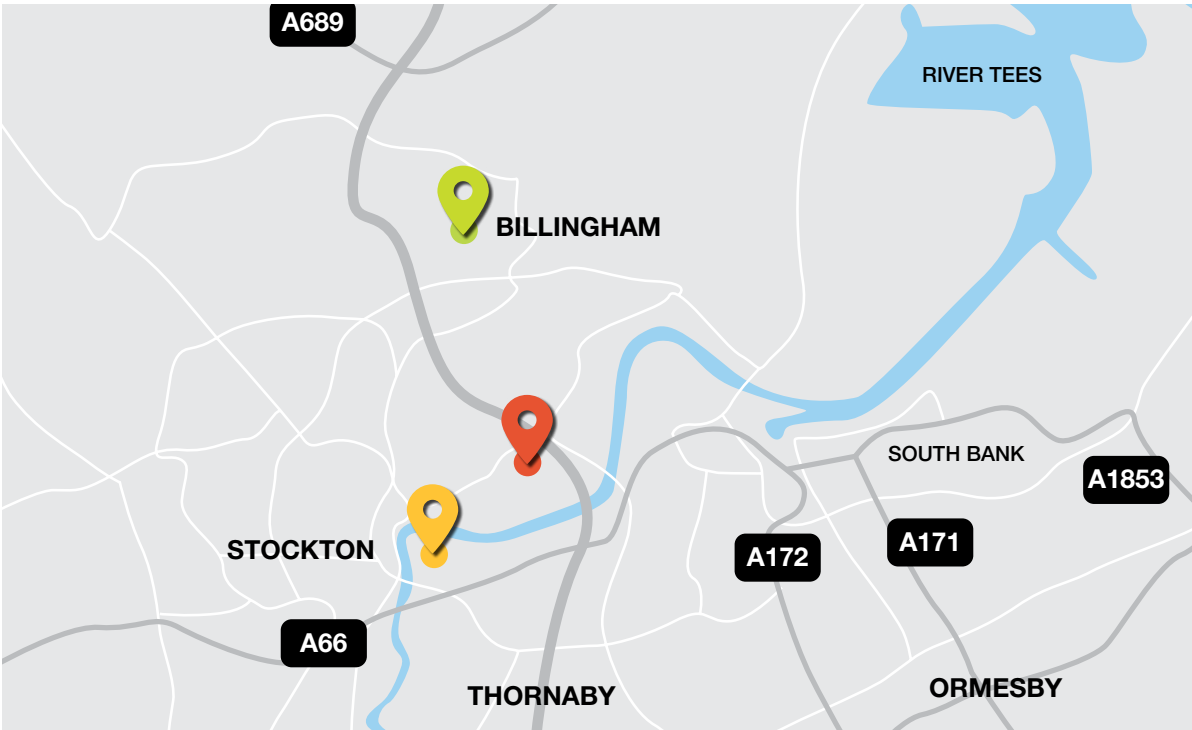

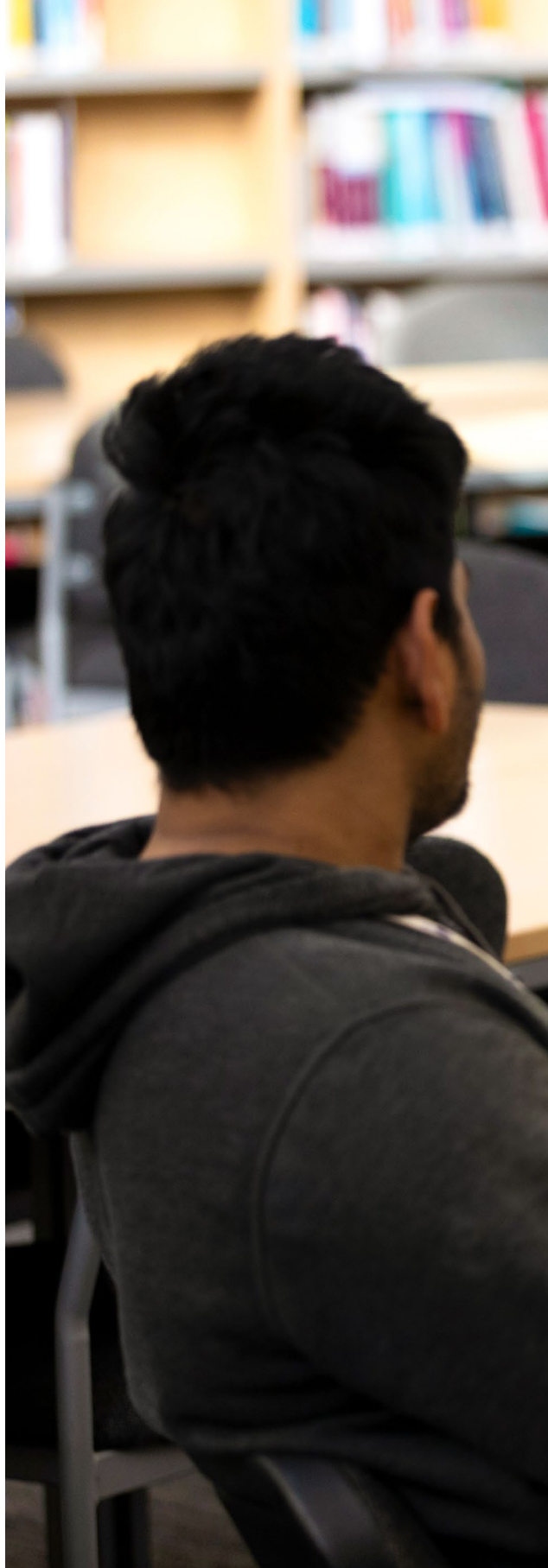
